Monday 13th July-Brill Kids Fest at Wychwood Park

Our Year 6 children will be visiting Wychwood Park on **Monday 13th July** to take part in the “**Brill Kids Fest**” Children’s conference. Chancery will be funding this event, therefore there is no cost.

This exciting event will bring together pupils from across Chancery Multi Academy Trust. The day is designed to celebrate the unique talents of every child and provide an opportunity for pupils to express themselves and enjoy a shared experience with others and to be the best that they can be.

Important information:

- **Lunch:** All children will be provided with a free lunch at Wychwood. We have already shared dietary requirements based on our school records. They will also be supplied with a water bottle that they can refill during the day.
- **What to bring:** Rain coat and change of footwear if a wet day and sun caps and sun cream already applied if a sunny day.
- **Uniform:** All children must attend in **full school uniform**, but wear trainers as footwear.
- **Departure:** The coach will depart promptly at **9:00am**. Please ensure your child arrives at school on time, as this is essential for event logistics.
- **Return:** We will return to school before the end of the school day, and pupils can be collected as usual.

We will be hiring a drone to take overhead photographs, as well as on the ground photographs to remember the day.
