If you don't have playdough, then use lego or sand</p>	<p><i>Story telling</i> Re tell one of your favourite stories to a grown up. Can you act it out too?</p>	<p><i>Cooking</i> Can you bake or cook something with someone at home. Hope it's yummy!</p>
<p><i>Throwing and catching</i> Can you throw and catch a ball (alone or with a partner) 10 times? Can you count the catches? Can you count them backwards?</p>	<p><i>Skipping</i> Here's a really tricky one – can you skip with a rope?</p>	<p><i>Hobbies</i> We have talked about hobbies in school – can you draw a picture of you doing your favourite hobbies and have a go at writing what they are?</p>	<p><i>Cutting</i> Cut out different shapes and create a shape picture</p>
