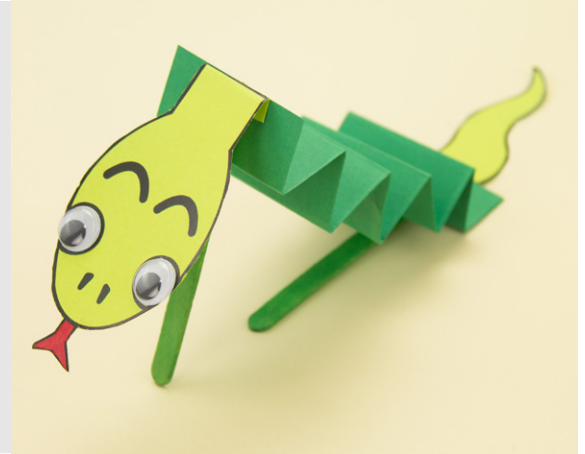
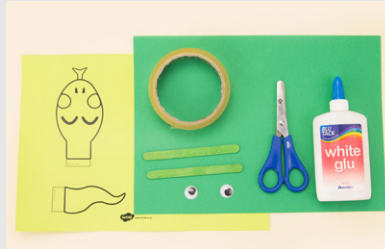

Zigzag Snake

Supplies

- Coloured card
- Lolly sticks
- PVA glue
- Wobbly eyes
- Scissors
- Sticky tape
- Snake head and tail template



1 First, print the head and tail template out onto coloured card. Then carefully cut them out. You may wish to use pens or a little red paint to colour in the snake's tongue.



4 Fold the end of the strip of card over and then turn the strip of paper over. Fold the strip of card backwards and then turn over again. Repeat this process for the length of the card, to create a zigzag shape.



2 Next, stick two googly eyes onto the circles on the snake's head.



5 Now you are ready to stick all of the pieces together to create the snake! Using PVA glue, stick the head onto one end of the zigzag and the tail onto the other end.

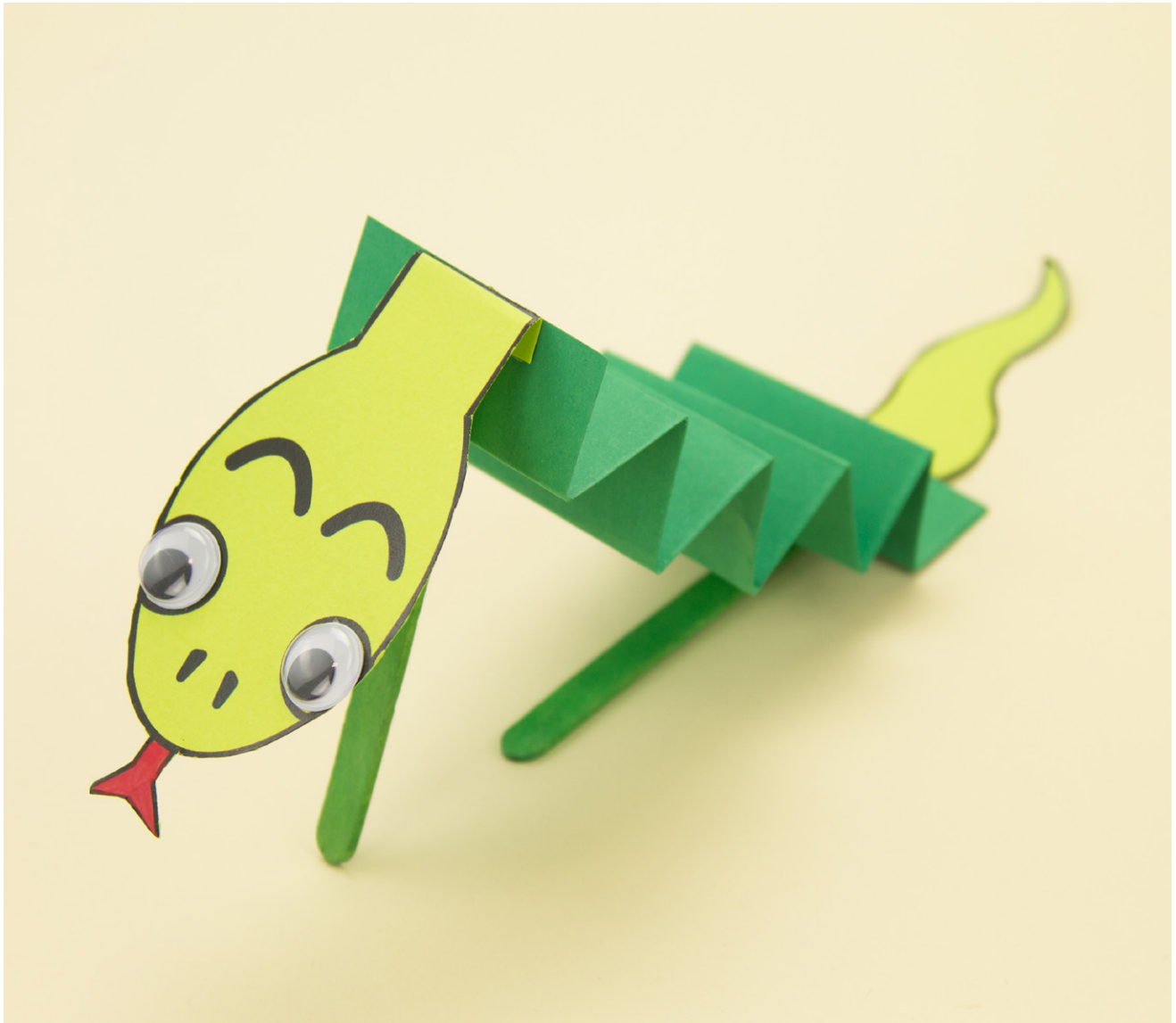


3 Next, choose a piece of coloured card to be the snake's body. Cut a long strip from it, about 6cm wide.



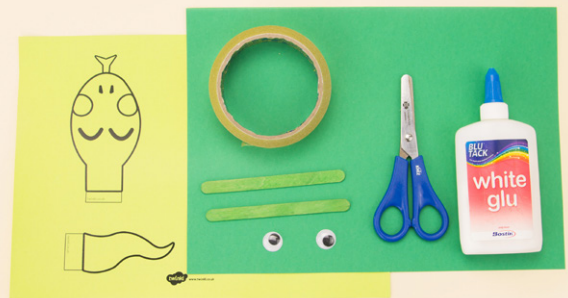
6 Finally, use the sticky tape to stick a lolly stick onto both ends of the zigzag between the folds of paper, to enable your snake to be moved!

Zigzag Snake



Supplies

- Coloured card
- Lolly sticks
