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Cardboard Tube Tiger

Supplies

- Small cardboard tube
- Orange pipe cleaner
- Tiger template
- Orange and black paint
- Paintbrush
- Coloured pencils or felt tip pens
- Black felt tip pen
- PVA glue
- Scissors
- Sticky tape
- Googly eyes (optional)



1 First, paint the cardboard tube orange and allow to dry.



2 Now take the tiger templates; you will need two sets of legs and a head. You can either use the pre-coloured ones or colour in your own using coloured pencils or felt tip pens. Then draw a face onto the tiger's head using the black felt tip pen. You could also stick some googly eyes on if you have them.



3 Next, carefully cut out the tiger templates. This can be a little tricky, so you may need an adult to help you. Make sure you don't cut off the tabs!



4 Once the orange tube is dry, draw or paint some black stripes all around it.



5 Now, fold over the tabs on the head and leg templates.



6 Next, carefully cut two slots into the underside of the tube, near each end, you may need an adult to help you.



7 Carefully push the leg tabs through the slots and fold the tabs over. Secure with a little sticky tape.



8 Next, put a little tape onto the head tab and fix inside one end of the tube.



9 Finally, cut a piece of pipe cleaner to be your tiger's tail. Fix the tail inside the other end of the tube using a little sticky tape.

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
