Keep trying to beat your best score!</p>	<p><i>Super measuring!</i> Find some different items around your home (shoes, toys, books, scarves – anything!) and put them in order of size from smallest to largest.</p>	<p><i>Super sounds!</i> Using your school reading books or books from home, how many words can you find with the following sounds: ai, ee, igh, oa, oo, ar, or, ur, ow, oi, ear, air, er ?</p>
<p><i>Super Spring!</i> Keep your eyes peeled for signs of Spring and take photos of them.</p>	<p><i>Super counting!</i> Practise counting forwards and backwards to 10 starting from different numbers</p>	<p><i>Super steps!</i> How many footsteps from your front door to your back door? From your back door to the end of your garden? From your bedroom to the bathroom? What happens to the number if you take bigger or smaller steps? Can you write each of the numbers down?</p>	<p><i>Super sentences!</i> I can... I am... I can see... He can... He is... She can... She is... Use these as ideas for sentence starters. Can you finish the sentence?</p>
