You could draw, colour, paint or even make out of playdough, a new front cover for your book</p>	<p>Make a bookmark so that you don't lose your place in your book. Make it bright and colourful!</p>	<p>Throw and catch a ball 20 times without dropping it! If you can do this, move further away from your partner.</p>
